## TRANSPORTATION

## **ITINERARY**

- Scenarios, with each day's activities, will be emailed and posted once WGI posts our performance schedule. We will use the Band App while in Dayton for communication.

## **ITEMS TO BRING**

---

- Personal items (clothes, toiletries and sunscreen). All prescription meds must be given to Jessica Shannon prior to the trip (only if the student's parents are not traveling to Dayton).
- UNIFORM! Uniform shirt, pants, under garments, several pairs of black socks, black shoes.
- Instrument, supplies such as stick tape, sticks, mallets etc.
- Money for travel days and for meals not provided by WLPE (will be announced prior to the trip), tickets, and miscellaneous spending.
- Families: bring a lawn chair and EZ-up type portable canopies if you have one for shade (or shelter from the rain) as we may be practicing outside.

## **MEDICATION**

---

It is the Walled Lake School District policy that all prescription medication be stored and administered by a designated adult. Over-the-counter medication will be also administered by a designated adult, only if the OTC form for that student is on file with WLPE.

- An Authorization to Administer Medication form must be completed and SIGNED by your physician and on file with WLPE. All medications must be in a labeled prescription container and in the same dosage described on the medication form. Place in Ziploc with the name clearly printed on the bag. Give the medication to Jessica Shannon by the evening of April 16<sup>th</sup>.
- It is HIGHLY recommended that if the member's parents are travelling to Dayton, that they store and administer the medication (both prescription and OTC) to their son or daughter. This will drastically reduce time and paperwork on both your part and on the part of the trip organizers. Thanks for your cooperation with this!

## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

---

WLPE is a Walled Lake District sanctioned organization. Therefore, we must follow the district guidelines in regard to field trips. Everyone should already be aware of the "rules of the road", so they will not be detailed in this flyer.

### **Member Responsibilities**

- To follow the member action statement, which will guide you in how you act and represent the group both on the floor and off the floor. This includes following the WLCSD Code of Conduct.
- No student is permitted to leave the hotel unless they are accompanied by a parent chaperone.
- No members of the opposite sex are allowed in any room together.
- Be courteous to other guests in the hotel and to the hotel management.
- No PDA whatsoever.
- "In room" on the schedule means only those members assigned to the room are to be in the room.
- "Lights out" means lights out – including all electronics.
- To have fun!

## Chaperone Responsibilities

- To ensure the safety of the students.
- To check with students and monitor all activity at all times in the hotel.
- No one will be permitted to leave the hotel property unless our schedule provides the opportunity and the students check out with their chaperone (this includes going to grab food).
- Make sure students follow the policies stated above.
- Get cell phone number of students in your group and make a plan for the end of Finals.

## Driver Responsibilities

- Transport students to Dayton and within the city.
- Follow the scenarios and ensure that the kids are dropped off timely.
- Don't make stops that are not listed on the schedules.

## On and Off Volunteers Responsibilities

- Have ticket or wristband with you when we are ready to go into the building.
- Be on time to the meeting area (per schedule).
- Remember what you are signed up to help with.
- Contact Mark if you find an issue with props/equipment.
- Plan for safety ahead of time (i.e. gloves, proper shoes, etc.)
