New York Departure timeline

Monday, November 16:

- Student id drop off-**Band room at the end of rehearsal.**

Wednesday, November 18:

- Snack donation drop off - **Band room at the end of rehearsal**

Thursday, November 19:

- Uniform check in- **Band room at the end of rehearsal.**

Saturday, November 21:

- Luggage check in students, chaperones and staff. Please bring your signed luggage check form with you. **At the end of rehearsal.**
- Medication check in. Please pack just enough for the number of days we will be gone. All medication must be in the original bottle. : **Orchestra room at the end of rehearsal.**

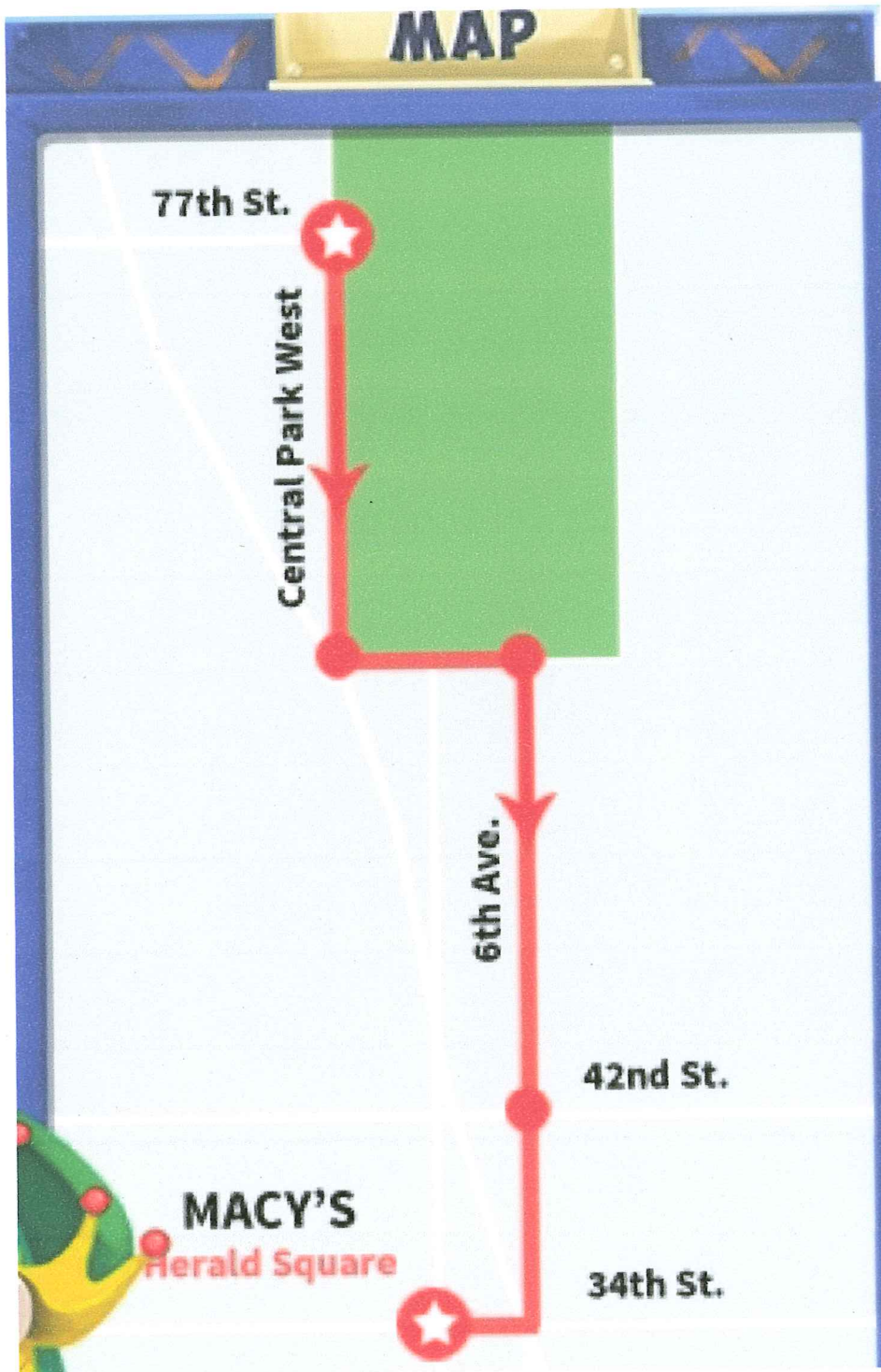

 - Camera, personal music players (iPod, iPhone, etc)

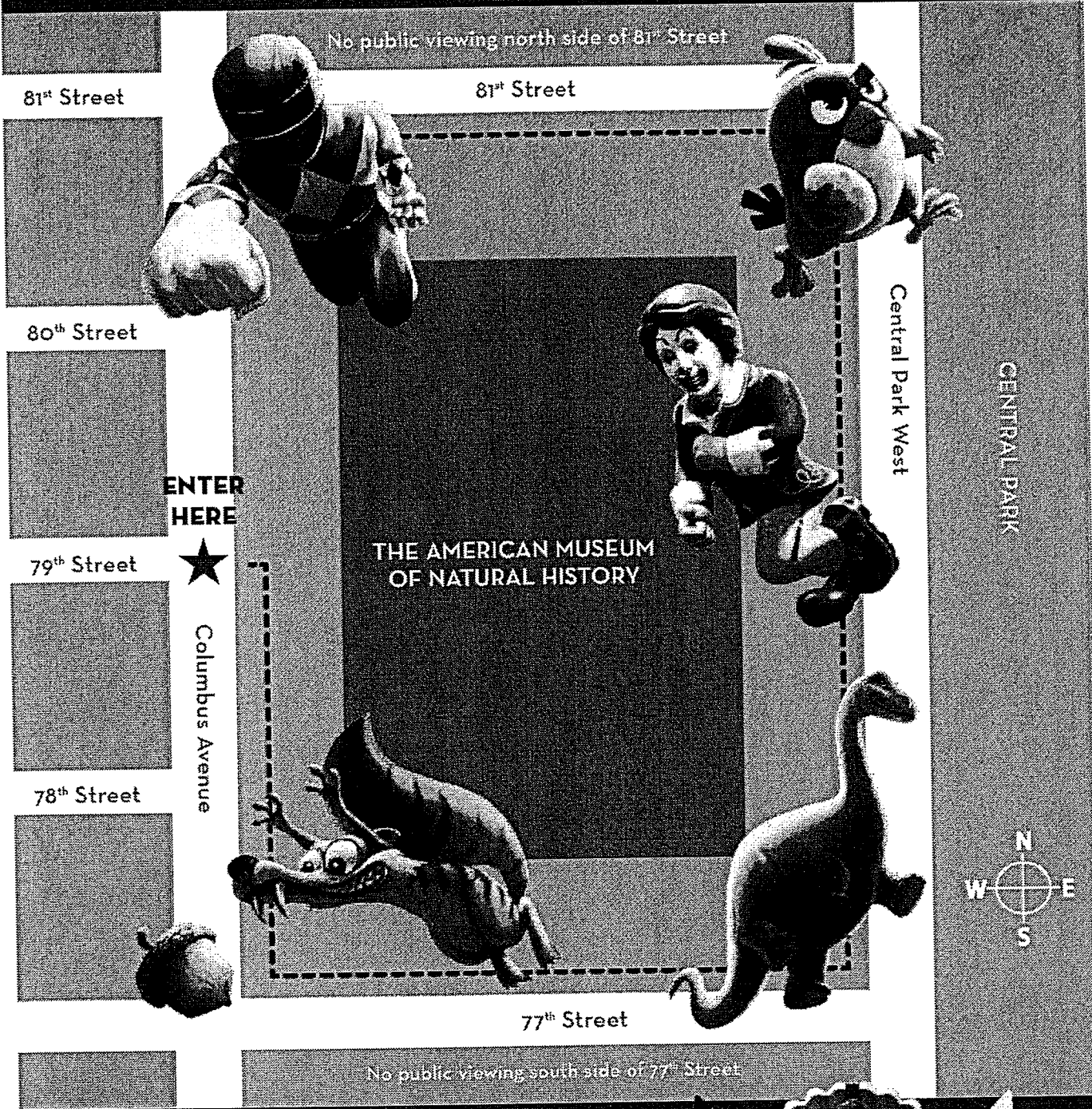
